Following an emergency, staff should login or check emergency numbers periodically for updates on the incident status and directions from agency senior staff.

Senior Staff Communication Plan

Each office has a communication plan to reach their employees.

Please make sure your personal contact information is up to date. You may login to ESS to do so.

Our contingency plan aims to preserve our computer systems, key functions, and office locations.

Evacuation Information

If you are asked to evacuate any one of HPD's buildings, please do so. Each office has a re-assembly point that you should go to postevacuation.







